



Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) app registration for employees, external and associated users.

This guide describes, how to install and register the NetIQ app on a smartphone or tablet, enabling the user to use Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) when accessing the rapidly increasing number of MFA enabled systems and services at KU.

IMPORTANT!!

- You must have a UCPH username and a valid password.
- You must be enrolled on the multi factor authentication solution.
 - If you are not already registered on the multi factor solution, it is possible to register by using Nem-ID. If you need assistance in doing so, you can use the following link to get help in using Nem-ID for registering <https://it.ku.dk/hjaelp-til-login>.
 - If you don't have Nem-ID, you must then contact the Support on 35 32 32 32 in order to get help with the registration of the Multi Factor Solution (MFA).
 - If you are an associate or external user, then KU might not be able to validate you using CPR, while trying to register using Nem-ID. If you in this regard should encounter any issues, you must contact the KU-IT Support on 35 32 32 32, where you will be guided through the registration process.
- The **NetIQ Auth** app can be used only from one phone or tablet. If you need to use it on a different phone or tablet than your primary phone or tablet, you must first disable the app on your primary device.
- When setting up the NetIQ-app on a smartphone or tablet, it is a requirement that you use Android Version 8 or later, or if you are using Iphone, it must be Version 10.0 or later..
- If you get a new phone at a later time, you must install and register the app again following this guide. The only change is that under section 4, the old phone will be listed under **Enrolled Authenticators**. Click on the Smartphone icon and continue the guide.

Please have in mind that while reading this guide, you will from time to time be required to use your smartphone or tablet, it is therefore important to have your desired devices ready.

1.  Download the **NetIQ** app in the App store (Apple).

Notice that the app minimum requirement if iOS version 9 or OS version 6 for Android.

- If you have an Android phone or tablet, you will find the app in Google Play. The app has the following icon on Android:



- **First time you open the app:**
 - Give the NetIQ app permission to send notifications and accept the use of your phone's camera.
 - You will normally use Touch ID to log in, but you will be asked to create a pincode, as an extra login. Use your pincode, if Touch ID does not work.

On your computer you now access the website mfa.ku.dk to register for NetIQ.

NOTE: Is it the first time you enrol the NetIQ App (or if you need to enrol the app again) You need an Emergency password, you obtain the password by calling UCPH Support 35 32 32 32.

Log in with your UCPH username and password.

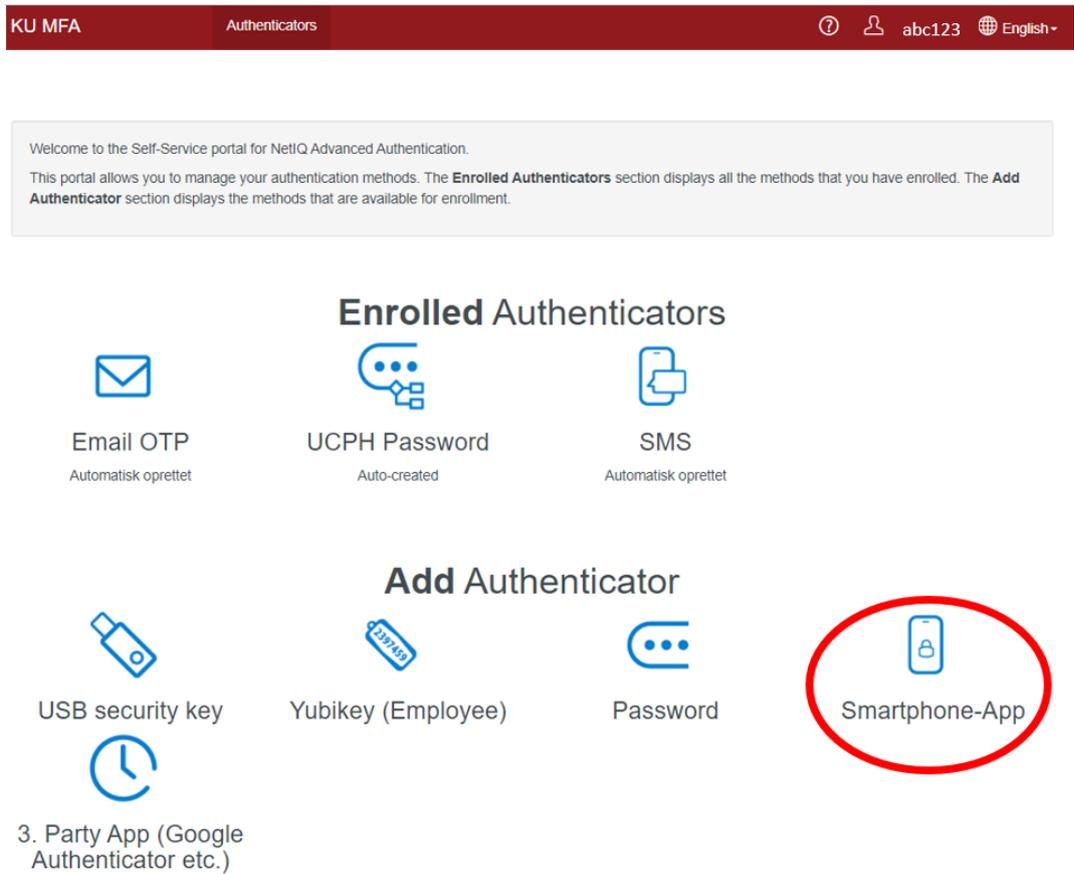

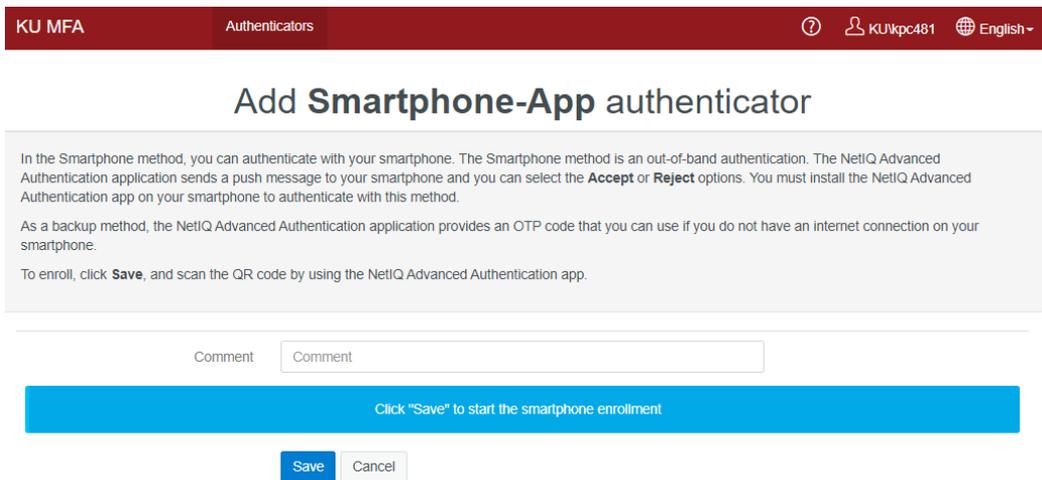

Add Smartphone-App authenticator

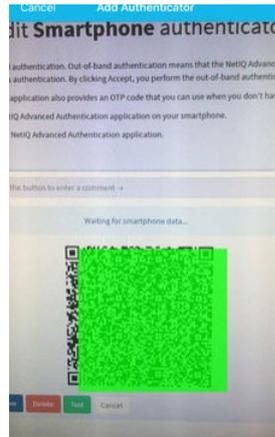

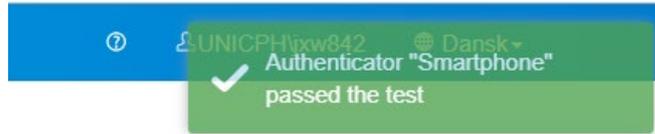
